## Year 3/4

This Term, students will explore the element of form through the exploration of clay. Students will create a low-relief clay home inspired by traditional architecture in Japan, and Edwardian terrace houses found in Melbourne.

Students will learn how to roll a slab, create clay coils, and join clay surfaces together using the 'Score and slip' method.

To complete the processes, students will create an oil pastel wax-resist on their bisque-fired homes.

## Year 5/6

This Term, students will explore the element of form through the exploration of ceramics. Student will follow clay procedures to create a curated collection of small earthenware homes. Students will learn how to roll a slab, slice out their designed shape, stamp details, and apply underglaze and glaze.

Students will also explore printmaking through the creation of a unique foam-relief print. Students will be inspired by First Nations' artist, Jimmy Pike and his celebrated lino prints.
