### Writing

This term, Prep students will be writing information reports about a variety of topics.

#### Concepts About Print

- Capital letter at the beginning of a sentence
- Full stop at the end of a sentence
- Spaces between words

#### Spelling

- Hearing and recording sounds in words using developing letter-sound knowledge
- Spelling some high frequency words

#### Handwriting

- Writing letters using the correct formation
- Writing on dotted thirds
- Developing our fine motor skills



### Reading

In Term 3, we will be continuing to reinforce the concepts introduced in Term 2, including;

#### Phonological Awareness:

- Syllables
- Identifying the initial, middle and end sound in words

#### Comprehension Strategies:

- Non-Fiction book features
- Synthesising
- Summarising



#### Sounds/Write:

- Identifying letters and common sounds
- Digraphs e.g. sh, th, ch
- Recognising high frequency words (common words)







# Inquiry/SWPBS




In Inquiry, students will be exploring living things. They will investigate animal families and their features and look at different animal habitats. They will also explore a variety of life-cycles.




# Homework
