



# Japanese 2026

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## Curriculum

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### Prep

During Term One, the Prep students will be learning greetings, how to introduce themselves and learn about cultural gestures such as bowing.

### Grade 1/2

This term the Grade 1/2 students will be learning colours and animals, so they can convey what things they like and dislike through questioning and answering

### Grade 3/4

Students from the Grade 3/4 learning community are learning how to re-tell the story of 'Ookii Kabu' (The Enormous Turnip), and perform it to the class. They will also learn how to read and use a hiragana chart to decode words.

### Grade 5/6

Students from Grade 5/6 are learning about Japanese Primary Schools, and observing differences and similarities between them. They will also learn how to ask and reply about common school items.

On Thursday the 29th of February we will be having our annual Harmony Day celebrations!
