

Music Term 1 2026

Foundation

Students are learning how to be active and thoughtful participants in the Music classroom. We are focusing on listening, singing and dancing, then stop and start with the music cues. We will explore our singing voices and fundamental elements of music through tempo, pitch and dynamics using a variety of untuned percussion instruments.

Grade 1 & 2

Students are furthering their exploration of Music. We are continuing to focus on developing our abilities to listen, sing and respond to music cues. We continue to strengthen our singing voices and deepen our understanding elements of music through tempo, pitch and dynamics through untuned percussion instruments. We will start to investigate the glockenspiel, its origins and how to play with ostinato and to a steady beat.

Grade 3 & 4

We are focusing on exploring music elements of tempo, dynamics and pitch through learning and understanding the ukulele. They will begin to understand of the elements of music and their ability to interact with other musicians as they develop their music knowledge and skills. They listen for and perform independent rhythms over an underlying beat and recognise differences between notes moving by fingers to form basic chords.

Grade 5 & 6

We are focusing on deepening students understanding of music elements and musicianship through a variety of pitched instruments and untuned percussion. We will expand their knowledge of scales, chord formation and melody making. They will begin listening journals to further expand their own journey of understanding the way music is utilised in cultures and their personal journey of music appreciation.
