

Music Term 2 2026

Foundation

Students are continuing to learn how to be active and thoughtful participants in the Music classroom. We are focusing on listening, singing and dancing, then stop and start with the music cues. We are beginning to explore the concept of inner hearing and using our voices with correct pitches. We will continue to expand on the elements of music through tempo, pitch and dynamics using untuned percussion instruments.

Grade 1 & 2

Students are furthering their exploration of Music. We are continuing to focus on developing our abilities to listen, sing and respond to music cues. We will expand their understanding of rhythmic composition and music notation in group writing sessions and collaborative activities. We continue exploring the glockenspiel and introduce tuned bells to further explore solfage, steady beats and understand melodies.

Grade 3 & 4

We are continuing the exploration of the music elements of tempo, dynamics and pitch through learning and understanding the ukulele. We will also deepen and expand their understanding of rhythmic composition and music notation in group writing sessions and collaborative activities. We will listen and perform independent rhythms over an underlying beat and recognise differences between notes moving by fingers to form basic chords and strumming patterns.

Grade 5 & 6

We are focusing on deepening students understanding of music elements, musicianship and group collaboration through bucket drumming. We will then expand their knowledge of scales, chord formation, rhythm and melody compositions through the keyboard. They will continue listening journals to further expand their own journey of understanding the way music is utilised in cultures and their personal journey of music appreciation.
