## Prep

Students will continue to enhance their cutting and pasting skills. Additionally, they will explore the art element of form by creating a clay bird, which they will decorate using underglaze.

## Year 3/4

Students will explore a range of watercolor techniques to create an aerial view of a location within their community. Their artistic inspiration will be drawn from the works of First Nations artists.

## Year 1/2

Students will enhance their cutting and pasting skills through the creation of a delightful collagraph print titled 'Backyard Bird.' Additionally, they will explore the concept of Possum Skin Cloaks and produce artwork that reflects special journeys.

## Year 5/6

Students will create a unique self-portrait based on a photograph, utilizing Posca pens, paint, and transparency sheets. They will also explore the concept of identity by developing a detailed watercolour identity map.
