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## Reader's Workshop

Author's craft, inferring, synthesising

This term, in Reading, we will be learning about Author's Craft, where students will be exploring the different techniques author's use. We will then, move to inferring where students will use clues from the text and pictures to aid their comprehension. Finally, the students will be practising their synthesising skills, where they will take what they already know, and put it together with their new learnings. Students will be continuing their weekly guided reading sessions.



## Writer's Workshop

Narratives, Poetry



"Those who tell the stories rule the world."

The ability to tell a captivating story is one of the things that makes human beings extraordinary. It's how we connect to each other. It's something to celebrate, to study, to perfect.

In Term 3, students will be exploring narratives. They will be creating stories including series of related events, problem, and a solution. They will be encouraged to use WOW words, descriptive language, character features and author's craft to make their writing extraordinary.

We will also be exploring poetry. Students will experiment with creating funny poems, shape poems, haiku poems, acrostic poems, and more.

## Maths Workshon

Sharing, 3D shapes, Mass, Probability



For Numeracy in Term 3, Year One students will start by exploring the concept of sharing. They will be sharing sets of objects equally using one-to-one correspondence. They will also investigate 3 dimensional shapes, looking at the different features and properties. In Chance they will be exploring the language and categorising events as 'will happen', 'won't happen' and 'might happen'. Students will also investigate the concept of mass and use informal units to compare objects.

## Inquiry

History

This term's Inquiry focus will be 'Historical Knowledge'. Students will be unpacking the topic of 'Personal Histories' with the essential question of "What have we learnt from early families?" Students will also investigate where their family members were born and raised (particularly grandparents) and creating their own family trees.
