

## Numeracy

This term in Numeracy, students will be exploring multiplication and division using a range of efficient mental and written strategies.

They will also be exploring areas of data that link to our Kidpreneur Inquiry unit, as well as area, mass, 2D shapes and transformations.

## Inquiry

This term during Inquiry, students will partake in our Kidpreneur program. Kidpreneur involves students creating their own micro-business where they will design a product from start to finish as well as designing all the marketing to promote it. Students will also be working to a budget and the products they create will be sold at an end of term market. All profits will be donated to a charity chosen by each class. Students learn real world skills such as working to a budget, communication, compromise and collaboration with peers as well as what it takes to run a successful business.

## Reading

This term in Reading, students will continue to meet in small guided reading groups to develop their comprehension, fluency and decoding when reading. As a class, students will further develop the comprehension skills of questioning, summarising and synthesising whilst continuing to develop their reading stamina through independent reading.

## Writing

This term in Writing, students will expand their understanding of writing different text types and continue to practise their writing skills including handwriting, editing and revising. The text types we will be exploring are response texts and discussions (two-sided persuasive).

## Camp

This year we will be attending PGL Campaspe Downs Adventure Camp from the 27st - 30th July. PGL Campaspe Downs is an hour's drive from Melbourne and set amid 180 acres of natural bushland in the Macedon Ranges, close to Kyneton and Hanging Rock. Some of the camp's activities include a giant swing, flying fox, challenge course and archery just to name a few!

## Homework

It is encouraged that your child is regularly completing homework task in preparation for High School. Students should be reading for at least 20 minutes every day and recording this in their diary. They also have SMART spelling words to learn each week. Optional additional homework includes Mathletics, Study Ladder, Reading Eggs and EPIC Readers.
