

NEWPORT GARDENS PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENT DRESS CODE POLICY

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Newport Gardens Primary School's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Newport Gardens Primary School's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- support Newport Gardens Primary School's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities
- reduce student competition on the basis of clothing
- enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community

The School Council has developed a dress code that we believe provides a range of choices for students and is cost effective for families.

SCOPE

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE

The full list of Newport Gardens Primary School compulsory school uniform items are available at Appendix A to this policy.

General appearance

While at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities, Newport Gardens Primary School students must comply with the following:

- Uniforms must be clean and in good repair
- Uniforms must be clearly marked with the owner's name
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided these undergarments are hidden.
- It is preferred that undergarments are in school colours – navy blue or white.

Jewellery and cosmetics

Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery to school. Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, and watches, are the only acceptable jewellery.

Cosmetics may not be worn at school. Only clear nail polish is permitted.

Hair and Sun safety

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back to help restrict the spread of nits and lice and for student safety. It is highly recommended that long hair be tied back using sensible hair ties, ribbons or scrunchies to prevent the spread of head lice. We encourage hair accessories such as clips, headbands, scrunchies and elastics to be in navy, turquoise or white.

School uniform hats must be worn outside in Term 1 and 4. School uniform hats may also be worn outside of this time period, by parent or student choice.

Hats are not to be worn inside.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet the Australian Standards 1067 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.

Other:

- Appropriate footwear is to be worn. Summer sandals with covered toes, school shoes or pull-on school boots or runners are permitted. No thongs or open-toed sandals are permitted.
- Sports T-shirts representative of our House Groups will be available for purchase at the administration desk. These are to only be worn on House-colours Day and Athletics Day as well as other whole-school sport events. These are not compulsory.
- The school shall offer graduation tops that may be purchased for students in grade 6. The design of these tops will be influenced by student discussion with the final design being approved by the principal or their representative. These tops will be ordered in the year prior to the student entering Year 6.
- Parents may purchase items of uniform that do not have the school logo from other sources, so long as there is a direct match in colour and style. All other items must be purchased through the school's supplier.
- The school bag with logo is highly recommended as it is specifically designed for comfort, back safety, and durability. Parents choosing not to purchase the school bag may purchase a plain navy-blue bag instead.
- During casual clothes days, students must still cover their shoulders and mid-riff, wear closed toe footwear, be SunSmart in terms 1 and 4 and not have any offensive material on their clothing

Support for families experiencing difficulty

IMPLEMENTATION

Positive reinforcement and encouraging responsible behaviour, school connection and belonging are the preferred approaches to ensuring students comply with our uniform expectations.

Newport Gardens Primary School will ensure that this Student Dress Code is communicated to all families and students through our website. We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible. We will ensure consultation, including that of Junior School Councillors and Student Leaders are included in decision making and are encouraged to share ideas and suggestions.

Students wearing non-compliant uniform items will have a member of staff contact the family to discuss the non-compliance. This will also be discussed with the students if they are in our senior years.

Breaches of the Student Dress Code on a recurring basis, will result in a letter being provided to the parents by the classroom teacher. If non-compliance with the dress code becomes a continued occurrence, the principal will be informed, and a phone call home may be required. In this event, the school will continue to work with the student and family to support compliance.

Measures taken by Newport Gardens Primary School to address concerns about student non-compliance with the Student Dress Code will also be addressed in accordance with our Student Wellbeing and Engagement Policy.

EXEMPTIONS TO STUDENT DRESS CODE

We recognise that there may be situations where the application of this dress code may affect students unequally.

Students and their parents or carers may apply either in writing or in person to the Principal for an exemption to this Student Dress Code if:

- an aspect of this code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of their religious, ethnic, or cultural beliefs or background
- the student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code
- the student or their parents/carers can demonstrate particular economic hardship that prevents them from complying with the dress code.

When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, they will:

- consider the grounds for the exemption request
- explain the process to the student and/or their parents/carers

- encourage the student and/or their parents/carers to support their application with evidence.

The principal or delegate will then try to negotiate a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. If an exemption is not allowed, then written reasons will be provided to the student and/or their parents or carers.
